Regular medical examination for Registered Radiation Handlers and Registered X-ray Handlers in FY2023 “First Semester” will be conducted in accordance with Article 13 of the Regulations Regarding Control of Radioisotopes, etc. at Kyoto University (established based on Notification 50, 2019) and Article 17, Paragraph 2 of the Guidelines on Radiation Control.

1. Eligible Person

2. Health Checkup Details

Web interview only

- ※ Some of the items will be omitted for those who conform to the omission criteria stipulated in the Industrial Safety and Health Act (Article 56, Paragraph 3 of the Ordinance on Prevention of Ionizing Radiation Hazards) and whose doctor deems it unnecessary for this medical examination.
- ※ Those who cannot be omitted will be notified separately only if applicable.

3. Of those eligible, registrants who registered prior to 2000 and have been continuously engaged in radiation work are omitted from blood testing. However, there are those who do not have past blood test data. This condition makes it difficult for the industrial doctor to decide, and we recommend that they undergo blood testing during FY2023.

- ※ Registrants who have blood test data but it has been more than 10 years since their blood was drawn are encouraged to take a blood test during the year 2023.
- ※ In those cases, please refer to the supplementary documents separately notified to apply for blood tests.

For the web interview, the following items must be entered.

※ **Contents of the web interview**

Registration cannot be modified after entry.

Please make sure that you have thoroughly checked the information before registration.

※ **Web interview about eye, skin, and general.**

The check is not required for symptoms that are already treated at a hospital, chronic symptoms, pre-existing symptoms, or symptoms that are not work-related.

(Do not check for known causes, especially for skin, such as allergic dermatitis, hay fever, or atopic dermatitis.)

※ **For those who need additional medical examinations.**

Those who checked eye, skin, and general symptoms will be guided for additional medical examinations at each department (ophthalmology and dermatology) of Kyoto University Hospital or at the Health Care Office.

The decision will be made based on the results after the additional health checkups, so it will take time to make a decision.

※ Please note that if you input your web interview on the web late, you will not be able to receive a consultation at any of the departments.
